Journeyman Upgrade Training



Because of COVID-19, any journeyman upgrade training must be scheduled **by employer** through our Apprenticeship Administrator.

To schedule a class, please do the following:

There is a *minimum* of 10 members and a*maximum* of 20 members needed in order to schedule a class. Face masks are required. Lunch is *not* provided so attendees will need to bring their own lunch. Safety protocols will be followed while on the premises.

Also, the following have mandatory pre-requisites of Hoisting, Rigging and Signaling and Spyder Crane:

- NCCCO Mobile Crane Operator Written Test Prep
 4 days total, 2 Saturdays and 2 Sundays
 NCCCO Practical Test Prep and Test
 2 days, Saturday and Sunday
