On December 27, 2020, changes to the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) are underway since the President signed the Consolidated Appropriations Act, which contains the Economic Aid Act.

All employers in the State of California are required to notify their employees of certain rights and/or obligations, such as posting safety and health guidelines in areas easily accessible to workers.
