California Enacts (Retroactive) 2021 Emergency Supplemental Paid Sick Leave Law

On March 19, 2021, despite our opposition and the opposition of over 100 different organizations representing California businesses, Governor Newsom signed Senate Bill (SB) 95. The new law requires California employers with more than 25 employees to provide their employees with up to 80 hours of COVID-19 supplemental paid sick leave (SPSL) and takes effect on March 29, 2021. The leave is retroactive to January 1, 2021, and the statute expires on September 30, 2021.

We want to thank everyone who took the time to alert the Governor of their opposition to the bill at our request.
