

Cal/OSHA Clears Up Confusion on COVID-19 **Standards**

In what's been a dramatic and confusing series of events regarding COVID-19 workplace standards, today, the Cal/OSHA Standards Board adopted revisions to the COVID-19 **Emergency Temporary Standard** and the **Governor issued an Executive Order** ensuring the changes go into effect immediately.

Key changes in the revised emergency temporary standards pertain to face coverings, employers providing respirators, documentation for those "fully vaccinated", physical distancing, and more.
