#### Mid-Year Legislative Update

California State Legislature has crossed the midway point of the 2022 Legislative Session. Legislators had until June 2nd to move legislation out of their house of origin. Bills that did not clear that hurdle must be shelved for the year. Bills that survived the "house of origin" deadline are now being heard in policy committees in the corresponding "other" house (Assembly and Senate). All remaining measures must be passed out of the legislature and to the Governor for consideration by September 14th.

SCGMA continues to be highly effective in impacting the most significant industry bills that they have taken positions on. It is noteworthy to mention that SCGMA's position on certain legislative issues have changed.

- AB 594 (Maienschein D) Labor Code: alternative enforcement. Position: Oppose -> Active
- SB 423 (Wiener D) Land use: streamlined housing approvals: multifamily housing developments. Position: Oppose -> Active
- AB 1204 (Holden D) Contractors: contracts: restrictions. Position: Active -> Support
- SB 553 (Cortese D) Occupational safety: workplace violence: restraining orders and workplace violence prevention plan. Position: Active -> Oppose
- SB 630 (Dodd D) Contractors State License Board: regulation of contractors. Position: Neutral -> Support
