Per the CBA, Article 10, Section 10, page 13 - "Each Employer will be required to hold a weekly safety meeting with the employees working on any job site or in the shop. The Employer will be required to provide a sign-in sheet to verify attendance by their employees. These sign-in sheets will be available for inspection by any authorized Agent of the Union."
